

I²SL's Colorado Chapter is offering scholarship assistance to attend the 2024 I²SL Annual Conference to be held in St. Louis, MO on September 29 – October 2, 2024. Scholarship funds can be utilized to cover the costs of registration (not including workshops or tours), hotel, and a one year I²SL membership up to a maximum cost of \$2,500.00. The scholarship does not include reimbursement for meals (though the continental breakfast and lunch served during the event are included in the registration fee), parking, or optional events. The scholarship is open to anyone living in the State of Colorado and the Rocky Mountain region. If awarded, registration needs to be made on or before the early registration cut off. Awarded applicants must make their own travel accommodations and submit for reimbursement.
